

## **AUTOMOTIVE ROADSHOW - 2018**

Turkey: A Center of Excellence for Automotive Sector



Turkey aims at becoming one of the the world's 10 largest economies by 2023. In order to achieve this goal, the creation of a local brand (and of course, the local production) has become one of the priorities of the government. However, even if Turkey is well known as an excellent production hub for the automotive industry, the country needs to improve its R&D, design and branding capabilities.


**KEY FIGURES** 

•The **14**<sup>th</sup> largest automotive manufacturer in the world and the **5**<sup>th</sup> in Europe with 75% average export rate by the end of 2016.

- •There are **84 operational R&D centers** belonging to automotive manufacturers/suppliers in Turkey.
- Compared to the same period of the previous year, Turkish automotive industry's exports increased by **17 percent in** 2017 and the industry is the export champion with its **18 percent share in total export** while the imports for the same sector decreased by **8 percent.**
- Despite the strong increase in the sales, the automobile penetration in Turkey (165 cars per 1,000 people) is behind the European average of 500.




### Turkey's Key Partners


# 1.4 million units of vehicles in Turkey

Turkey is the largest export base of global OEMs in the region outside of EU with an average export rate of 75%. Around 1,100 component suppliers are working directly with them to support the production. With the parts going directly to the production lines of vehicle manufacturers, the localization rate of OEMs varies between 50 and 70 percent.

In Turkey, there are more than 250 global suppliers using the country as a production base. 28 of them are ranking among the 50 largest global suppliers.
